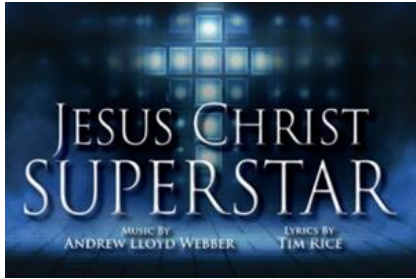

**21 at 10:00 and Fri June 27 at 1:30.**



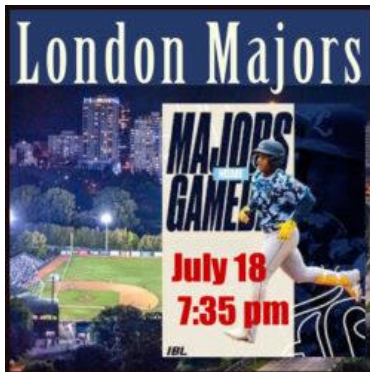
